

# Feral Cat Spays and Neuters

## Requirements:

- Cats must be in separate live animal traps
- Cats must receive ear-tip (universal sign that cat has been sterilized)
- Cats must receive Rabies vaccination
- Caretaker can bring up to 4 cats per day
- TCAP will accept 12 cats per day. Be sure to arrive early for check-in!



## 76010/76014 Zip Codes

- Free spays and neuters for feral cats at any TCAP location
- Free Rabies vaccine for feral cats at time of surgery
- Must show proof of residency

## All Other Zip Codes

- Free spays and neuters for feral cats at Burleson and Hurst clinics
- \$20 spays and neuters for feral cats at Arlington and Grand Prairie locations
- \$5 Rabies vaccine for feral cats
- \$20-\$40 fee for pregnant or crypt orchid cats
