<b>Experience Arlington Board of Directors (Formerly Arlington Convention and Visitors Bureau)</b>	The Board of Directors shall be responsible for establishing operating policies for the Bureau and for evaluating the progress of the Bureau in the attainment of its goals. The Board of Directors shall have full and complete power to transact all business and manage the affairs of the Bureau.
<b>Arlington Higher Education Finance Corporation</b>	This body was established as a nonprofit corporation for the purpose of promoting higher education and furthering educational opportunities of students through serving as a conduit issuer for private and charter school financings in Texas.
<b>Arlington Tomorrow Foundation</b>	This Board is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life in Arlington, Texas, today and for generations to come, the Arlington Tomorrow Foundation makes financial grants to projects and programs designed to have a positive impact on the people of our community.
<b>Downtown Arlington Management Corporation</b>	The Downtown Arlington Management Corporation is a private, non-profit community development organization whose purpose is to forge alliances between property owners, business interests, residents and the City of Arlington to improve and enhance the economic vitality and overall environment of Downtown Arlington.
