

Doskocil Drill Site Permit Stipulations

1. A sign will be displayed at the gate stating the well number, the name and number of the operator, the emergency 911 number, and the telephone numbers of two contacts.
2. On-site noise monitors established the ambient noise level at 57.7 dBA. During drilling, the allowable daytime sound level is 62.7 dBA and the allowable nighttime sound level is 60.7 dBA. Fracing operations shall not exceed 64.7 dBA.
3. The applicant proposes to enter into an Agreement with the City to lease one four-inch water meter, connect to a nearby fire hydrant, and purchase approximately four million gallons of water per well. The approved water site plan limits the rate of withdrawal to a maximum of 800 gallons per minute, respectively, as shown on the water source site plan. This site will utilize the existing on-site frac pond.
4. The transportation route to the site will travel from Interstate 20 Highway (I-20), take the Bowen Road exit and travel approximately 2.22 miles north to West Arkansas Lane. Turn east on Arkansas Lane and continue approximately 0.13 miles to the site access road on the right. Reverse directions to exit the site. Traffic to the Doskocil Drill Site is restricted Monday through Friday during the peak travel times between the hours of 7-9 a.m. and 5-7 p.m.
5. A secured entrance gate containing a Knox-Box keybox or pad lock or equivalent is required. All gates are to be kept locked when the Operator or his employees are not within the enclosure. On April 10, 2011, Fence Permit Number 2011-239514 was approved for an eight-foot high combination masonry stone wall and wrought fence. The fencing has been installed and the landscape plantings around the perimeter of the fence and street trees have been planted. Plantings consist of Live Oak and Eastern Red Cedar trees.
