

## **Lenox Drill Site Permit Stipulations**

1. A sign will be displayed at the gate stating the well number, the name and number of the operator, the emergency 911 number, and the telephone numbers of two contacts.
2. During drilling, the allowable nighttime sound level is 3 dBA over the established ambient level and the daytime sound level is 5 dBA over ambient. Fracing operations shall not exceed a 7 dBA increase.
3. All noise levels shall be measured at the well setback distance. Due to the proximity from protected uses, the exterior noise shall be continuously monitored in one-minute intervals and forwarded to the City daily.
4. The approved water site plan limits the withdrawal rate from the approved hydrant to a maximum of 1,100 gallons per minute.
5. The Lenox Drill Site transportation route commences at Interstate 20 Highway (I-20). From I-20 eastbound, take the Little Road exit and travel approximately 3,450 feet north to West Poly Webb Road. Head west on West Poly Webb Road approximately 2,525 feet to the site access road on the north. To exit the site, drive east on West Poly Webb Road approximately 2,525 feet back to Little Road. Travel south along Little Road 410 feet to gain access onto I-20.
6. After completion of all wells, a solid masonry wall with a minimum height of eight feet and landscaping must enclose all completed wells and tanks located within the operation site. Landscaping should consist of trees and shrubs which must be chosen from the Texas Smartscape List. One tree shall be provided every 35 linear feet and shrubs shall be spaced no greater than three feet on center. The property owner shall be responsible for the installation, preservation, and maintenance of all landscaping and physical features shown on this site plan.
7. Prior to any drilling activity at the site, operator shall install a sound wall on all four sides of the pad site, a solid wood fence along the east side of the property, and landscaping as shown on the attached landscape plan.
