

Rolling Hills Drill Site Permit Stipulations

1. A sign will be displayed at the gate stating the well number, the name and number of the operator, the emergency 911 number, and the telephone numbers of two contacts.
2. The ambient sound level is established at 59.9 dBA. During drilling, the allowable nighttime sound level is 62.9 dBA and the allowable daytime sound level is 64.9 dBA. Fracing operations shall not exceed 66.9 dBA.
3. The approved water site plan indicates different water plans for the drilling stage and the fracing stage, with a maximum flow rate of 300 gallons per minute (gpm) during drilling and 1000 gpm for fracing.
4. The transportation route commences at Interstate Highway 30 (I-30). From I-30, exit at Center Street and travel west along Ryan Plaza Drive and Lamar Boulevard to the existing site access road north of Lamar Boulevard. To exit the site, continue on Lamar Boulevard west to gain access to I-30.
5. Traffic routing during major events in Arlington's entertainment district, i.e., the Ballpark or Cowboys Stadium, requires coordination with the City. Rig move notifications must be date specific and should not coincide with major events.
6. The required masonry wall and landscaping were already installed at the Rolling Hills Drill Site in accordance with the approved zoning plan. Preservation and maintenance of both items are the responsibility of the operator or property owner.
7. Site development, other than drilling, shall be conducted only between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
