

**Resolution No. 13-153**

**A resolution relative to the Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee, its purpose, and appointees.**

WHEREAS, The City of Arlington, Texas seeks to adopt goals, policies, and strategies that ensure that the City is a pre-eminent city, providing an exemplary, safe environment in which to live, learn, work and play; and

WHEREAS, an updated Comprehensive Plan is a key policy document that will help make the City livable and thriving by providing the vision and goals for Arlington to grow and prosper as a 21<sup>st</sup> century city; and

WHEREAS, an advisory committee will enhance an updated Comprehensive Plan by providing public discussion about the City of Arlington's future, fostering partnerships, and raising public awareness;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ARLINGTON, TEXAS:

1.

That a Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee shall serve in a temporary advisory capacity concerning the development and review of a Comprehensive Plan. The Committee shall work with staff in formulating and reviewing the Comprehensive Plan's objectives, policies, strategies and actions. The Committee shall expire upon the completion of the advisory work and adoption of the Comprehensive Plan by the City of Arlington. Any previous committees charged with review of the Comprehensive Plan are hereby expired.

That the following members are hereby appointed to the Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee effective June 18, 2013. The terms of Committee members shall expire upon the completion of the advisory work and adoption of the Comprehensive Plan.
