



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS AND REQUEST FOR COMMENT ON THE CITY OF ARLINGTON DRAFT PROGRAM YEAR 2014 ACTION PLAN

The Program Year 2014 Annual Action Plan describes how the City of Arlington plans to use federal grant funds from Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnerships Program, and Emergency Solutions Grant to meet community needs. The primary objectives of the plan include decent housing, creation of a suitable living environment, and economic opportunities for Arlington residents who are primarily low- and moderate-income. The draft PY2014 Action Plan is currently under review by the City Council Community and Neighborhood Development Committee, and public comment is requested on the planned activities and budgets.

The draft plan is available for public comment for 30 days from March 10 to April 9, 2014 and is available at Arlington public libraries, the City Secretary's Office, and on the City website at <http://arlingtontx.gov/planning/grants/planningandreporting.html>. Interested parties are invited to attend all three of the following public hearings to review the Action Plan: 1) City Hall in the Council Briefing Room, on the third floor, 101 W. Abram Street, on March 11, 2014, at 6:00 p.m., or 2) Hugh Smith Recreation Center, in the Central Activity Room; Located in the Senior Recreation Center, 1815 New York Avenue, on March 27, 2014, at 6:00 p.m., and 3) Arlington Human Services Center, Conference Room A, 501 W Sanford Street, on April 3, 2014 at 6:00 p.m.. All facilities are wheelchair accessible.
