



WEEKEND BUSINESS ADVERTISING SIGNS
Building Inspections Division

Weekend Business Advertising Signs are allowed on the site of a business with the following conditions:

1. Construction: Signs should be rigid, two-dimensional displays.
2. Schedule: Signs will be allowed on the weekend, between noon Friday and noon Monday. A holiday falling on Friday or Monday will be considered part of the weekend and an additional day will be granted before or after the weekend as applicable. It is the responsibility of the operator of the business to remove the sign at noon Monday.
3. Size and Height: Signs shall not exceed 24" x 30" in size or be installed more than three feet above grade.
4. Sign Locations:
 - a. Signs must be located on the site of the business only. Only one sign per business shall be allowed per street front. Signs shall not be permitted in City right-of-ways.
 - b. Signs may not be closer than 40 feet to a street intersection.
 - c. Signs must be placed behind sidewalks (cannot be placed within the area between a street and a sidewalk). Signs should not encroach on sidewalks or the street. If there is no sidewalk, signs may not be placed nearer than 10 feet from the edge of the sign to the street curb (or edge of pavement, if there is no curb).
 - d. Signs shall not be placed in a motorist's "visibility triangle" per Article 9 of the Street Ordinance.

Any sign placed within the right-of-way is in violation of this policy and shall be considered abandoned property and subject to removal by the City. For additional information, please contact a sign inspector at 817-459-6508 or 817-459-6509.
