

Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Social Security Act was signed into law by President Franklin Delano Roosevelt on August 14, 1935, establishing the beginnings of a new social insurance system that today protects families against income loss due to retirement, disability or death of an income provider and assists in meeting some of the medical expenses of the elderly and long-term disabled; and

WHEREAS, the Social Security program is the cornerstone of economic protection on which workers can build additionally through pensions, insurance, savings and other income towards a comfortable retirement; and

WHEREAS, the Social Security Administration is committed to providing the American public choices for conducting business with the agency through its website that offers online services, applications, and program information for beneficiaries, employers and the public; and

WHEREAS, The City of Arlington recognizes the importance of Social Security benefits to the welfare of its citizens and joins the Social Security Administration in celebrating its past and in building its future.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W. Jeff Williams, Mayor of the City of Arlington, Texas, and on behalf of the Arlington City Council, do hereby proclaim Friday, August 14, 2015 as
