We had been thinking about getting a small dog since October. The plea in the Star-Telegram from the Ft. Worth shelter spurred us to action. We did not find the right dog for us from there, so I started looking diligently online. I found Murray on Petfinder.com on Saturday, and adopted him at the Southlake Petsmart on Sunday. He will have the pin in his femur removed tomorrow.

He is the most wonderful dog. He is smart, walks beautifully on a leash, and cannot wait to start further training. He has three kids who adore him, and my husband and I couldn't be happier. Murray is already spoiled, sleeping on satin sheets, and playing on our 15 acre mini-farm south of Fort Worth.
