

Stage 1 Drought Restrictions IN EFFECT

Arlington is currently under Stage 1 Drought Watering Restrictions. The goal of Stage 1 is to prohibit non-essential water use and save 5% of current consumption.

Restrictions include:

- Maximum two day watering schedule based on address. Clip the chart and post on your refrigerator as a reminder of your watering days. Remember to not water if rainfall occurs that week.
- No outdoor watering between 10 a.m. - 6 p.m. year round. Hand-held watering and the use of drip irrigation and soaker hoses may occur on any day and time.
- Water waste is prohibited. Be sure to check and adjust sprinkler systems that have leaks and runoff down the street.
- Washing of any vehicle is limited to the use of a hand-held bucket or hand-held hose with a shutoff nozzle. Vehicle washing may be done at any time at a commercial car wash.
