



Dear Arlington TX 2015 NNO participants,

For our Project365 program, we have chosen to partner with Safe Haven promote Domestic Violence Awareness in continuing efforts to support our community. Project365 is a program to extend the efforts of crime prevention, police-community partnership and neighborhood camaraderie beyond National Night Out. This yearlong program provides neighbors an opportunity to work together with the assistance of law enforcement to build a safer neighborhood.

The goal is to provide families with adequate supplies in order to rebuild their lives and move from fear to freedom. In anticipation of your National Night Out party, we are asking NNO registrants to gather your friends and neighbors and host a community drive in your community! We are asking for adult flip flops, African American hair care products and brushes, feminine hygiene products, children's play clothing, baby bottles, pack n' plays, and new/gently-used household and clothing items for women and their children.

This community drive is a great way to give back to your community and make a difference in women and children's lives. The first 75 NNO registrants that donate a minimum of 50 new or gently used items will receive a complimentary NNO party package.

Each party package contains 1 NNO banner, T-shirts (sizes will vary) and ball caps. The first 30 registrants will also receive a National Night Out BBQ apron!

All items can be dropped off at the Arlington Resource Center located at 401 W. Sanford Street #1400 (in the back of the building) on: Monday August 24th through Friday September 4th from 9:30am to 3pm. Any representative who is involved with organizing your gathering can deliver your donations and bring the receipt to Ott Cribbs (620 W. Division St.) to receive the party package. (Please ensure that representatives have basic registration information such as the location of your gathering as well as the name of the primary organizer).

To be eligible to receive a party package:

1. Your gathering must be registered for Public Safety visits. If you have not already done so, please visit: www.arlingtonpd.org and click on National Night Out to register.
2. One NNO party package will be issued per gathering/ location.
3. The location of your gathering must be within the boundaries of the City of Arlington TX.
4. Party packages will be issued on a first come, first serve basis.
5. All donations will be delivered to Safe Haven.

As we prepare for another year of strengthening our neighborhoods through community partnerships, I hope that each of you decide to participate in this meaningful endeavor.
