



City of Arlington - Arlington Water Utilities Pressure Reducing Valve (PRV) Rebate Program Application

A pressure reducing valve (PRV) rebate is available for Arlington property owners with current water pressure over 80 pounds per square inch (psi). The rebate is available for the cost of a PRV and permit fee, when a device is installed by a registered plumber in the City of Arlington.

Rebate Guidelines

- Participant must currently own and have a City of Arlington Water Utilities (AWU) account for the property where Installation of the PRV is to occur.
- Structure must have been built prior to September 8, 2003, or prior to water pressure increasing to over 80 psi and the account must not already have had a PRV installed.
- PRV's that reduce pressure in the residence, not the irrigation system, to 60 psi for a one story home and 70 psi for a two story home are eligible for a rebate.
- Each customer and property owner should carefully consider any suggestions, recommendations, or advice given by a licensed registered plumber about reducing the water pressure. The City of Arlington is not responsible for any problems that may be caused by a customer or property owner choosing to reduce the water pressure by installing a PRV.
- Applications must be received within 90 days of installing a PRV for the property. Rebates will be processed in the order they are received. Incomplete applications will not be processed and notification will be provided. All rebates are subject to the availability of funds.
- There is a limit of one PRV rebate per meter location for the lifetime of the property.
- Any PRV must be installed by a licensed plumber that is registered in the City of Arlington. A plumbing permit is required to install a PRV and an inspection of completed work must be performed by City of Arlington building inspectors prior to a rebate being issued. Note: Any time a PRV is installed for indoor water use, an expansion tank is required for safety reasons and it is typically installed near the hot water heater.

Rebate Program Steps

You must confirm that your static water pressure is 80 psi or higher by a registered plumber or by calling 817-459-6628 for an estimated calculation. Afterwards, contract a plumber to install a PRV, expansion tank (see above), and secure the plumbing permit. After installation, mail in the rebate application with copies of the itemized plumber invoice (dated after April 1, 2011) and plumbing permit enclosed. The application and copies can also be faxed to 817-459-6807. Originals of all copies must be present should an onsite verification occur. If the application is approved, a credit will appear on your utility bill within 60 days.

Please allow 10 working days for application processing. If the application is approved, a credit to your utility bill will occur within 60 days.

- I understand that the water pressure will be reduced by installing a PRV and I agree to keep the PRV in place as long as I own or operate said property.
- I understand that the City of Arlington is in no way responsible for the condition of the plumbing on my side of the meter, now or in the future.
- The City of Arlington does not guarantee materials, workmanship, performance, or durability of any PRV or plumbing company.
- I understand that the rebate is available for each indoor water supply meter on the property. If the application is approved, a credit to the utility bill will occur within 60 days.
